easy to use Android and IOS App; an on-board sound masking generator is also provided. RevNet amps are easily controlled via integrated WiFi or TCP/IP and include Phoenix connectors for fast, simple connections. The RevNet 2140-D offers the added convenience of Dante® I/O and control, with AES-67 support. RevNet amplifiers may be daisy-chained for scalability to any system size.
